

Part I Syllabus for DDE Students

D.D.E MA English Marks arrangement

Total marks- 1000

Part 1- 475

Part 2- 525

N.B: Students are required to attempt 2 broad ($15 \times 2 = 30$) and 4 short ($5 \times 4 = 20$) questions in each half.

MA Part-I

1st-4th Paper:

There are 2 halves for each paper. Each half carries 50 marks.

Total— $2 \times 50 \times 4 = 400$

Assignments - 75

Total in Part1=400+75=475

MA Part-II

6th -8th paper:

There are 2 halves for each paper. Each half carries 50 marks.

Total— $2 \times 50 \times 3 = 300$

9th and 10th paper: Special papers.

There are 2 halves for 9th paper only, each half carrying 50 marks. 10th paper carries 50 marks.

Total— $50 \times 3 = 150$

Assignments - 75

Total in Part2=300+150+75=525

Grand Total $475 + 525 = 1000$

Total Marks: 1000. Seventeen halves of 50 marks each (850 marks) + Assignment 150. Students are required to attempt 2 broad and 4 short questions ($15 \times 2 = 30$, $5 \times 4 = 20$)
